Feedback

ATP	Heritage assets - old railway workshops must be retained
ATP	Better and cheaper parking facilities must be available for people who work there

Connections and transport	Yes! To walkways and bike paths along corridor!
Connections and transport	Small buses to connect local communities to stations
Connections and transport	Lawson St: too narrow, too busy
Connections and transport	Need pedestrian walkway/cycleway from ATP to University/Codrington St
Connections and transport	ATP: with ownership changed would like to retain access to Redfern
Connections and transport	Weekends, travel, coffee, Carriageworks, lunch, sport, entertainment, Newtown, City
Connections and transport	Provide more shopping outlets so people can walk rather than havng to drive
Connections and transport	Provide better public transport
Connections and transport	Improve pedestrian access to Sydney Uni from Redfern Station
Connections and transport	Support for bikeways that are well made and means that bikes are not mingling with elderly pedestrians
Connections and transport	ATP: Walkway to Redfern Station is useful
Connections and transport	Planning for parking has been a problem in the past. Will need to be addressed if ATP is expanded
Connections and transport	Need destinations-based bike paths
Connections and transport	Enhance transport to provide journeys to Marrickville Metro, to King St, to Uni and UTS, beach access - trips across corridor

Central Station will be drop off centre, change to light rail etc. Encourage use of outlets, continue upkeep of buildings, will be focus for new transport arrangements
More buses (frequency)
Light rail metro: for every km of road tunnel provided ensure that a km of metro tunnel is provided
Central: better bus stops in Broadway, Elizabeth St and Eddy Ave.
Increase greening of walkways and plant flowers in the walkway arcades
Pedestrian bridge to connect Henderson + Wilson Rds
Lawson St - not enough pedestrian space (south)
Provide bridge access to Redfern URGENT
Public transport day and night to RPA
Light rail extension through the corridor to handle extra population
Overhead foot crossing to Sydney Uni from Redfern/Eveleigh
Celebrate the Aboriginal culture and heritage in South Sydney
Consider the installation of a new museum
Develop an education centre on local heritage and history
Provide opportunities for more art galleries
Develop a history/heritage trail for the area
Ensure that a building is reserved for museum housing aboriginal and European heritage
Provide for performance venues for live music, live entertainment, performing arts schools & colleges

Housing & Employment	Ensure that development provides affordable housing - not just sky high developments
	Low cost housing should be considered in new development for lower paid workers - like what happens in Harlem NY
Housing & Employment	Provide opportunities for retail - supermarket and restaurants
Housing & Employment	Hotels - accommodation supporting conferences and visitors to ATP
Housing & Employment	Ensure that there is provision for ageing in-place
Housing & Employment	Balanced development' - not all \$1m+ units
Housing & Employment	Continue the process of implementing small business villages where possible
Housing & Employment	Encourage innovative architectural design for housing and commercial
Housing & Employment	More pet friendly apartments
Housing & Employment	Supermarket!
Housing & Employment	Balance of affordable housing
Housing & Employment	All new apartments should have AT LEAST one dedicated parking space
Housing & Employment	New buildings MUST have adequate parking for all residents as part of development approval
Housing & Employment	Taller good design is better than mediocre mid height buildings
Housing & Employment	Maximum height for apartment buildings should be 8 levels
	The Erskineville Housing dept houses near the Swanson Hotel are a brilliant density solution for public housing
Housing & Employment	Retail small supermarkets allow walking for shopping if proximately located

Public Spaces & Social Facilities	A green walk would be great
Sustainability	Ensure that all power and communications cabling is installed underground
Sustainability	This area has some of the oldest infrastructure – water/sewerage/drains – electricity – telecoms – roads are narrow – you can't just go berserk with development without setting things right first
Sustainability	Definitely support precinct scale green facilities – market garden – individual veg plots for use
Sustainability	Efficient public transport to a variety of locations would encourage less car dependency. Apparently bus stops are being made fewer – this won't encourage people to use public transport
Sustainability	Have separate garbage bins for plastic and glass recycling – even somewhere central
Sustainability	Local commuter buses on on circuit routes in constant regular service
Sustainability	Reduce car dependency
Sustainability	Provide better public transport
Sustainability	Enhance pedestrian amenity
Sustainability	Local shops and small businesses
Sustainability	Connection to Green Square facilities
Sustainability	Include built car parks to allow for reality of extra cars in the area
Sustainability	Provide solar or fuel cell generation at every opportunity
Sustainability	Improved public transport - will reduce dependency on cars

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Provide opportunities for communal worm farms and composting
Put solar panels on ATP and Redfern Station
Provide opportunities for local food production - reduces transport distances and cost
Develop centre for local recycling/waste processing
Instal a bike path from Central and/or a walkway
